## ANNOUNCEMENT

**SUBJECT : 19<sup>th</sup> National Urban Pest Control Week or Zero Waste, Zero Pest Week**

The National Committee on Urban Pest Control (NCUPC) shall celebrate the **19<sup>th</sup> National Urban Pest Control Week or "Zero Waste, Zero Pest" Week** from September 21 to 27, 2015 with the theme ***"Adopting the Zero Waste, Zero Pest and Zero Pollution Lifestyle in Business Establishments"***. This celebration is also part of the "Clean Up the World Month" of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR).

Related activities shall be undertaken, as follows:

- Thanksgiving Mass and Opening Ceremonies on September 21 2015, 7:00 a.m. to be held at 2461 Arellano Avenue, Malate, Manila;
- Seminar-Workshop on Zero Waste, Zero Pest and Zero Pollution Lifestyle in Business Establishments: Reduce, Reuse & Recycle in coordination with different local government units in Metro Manila and in Maguindanao (*September 22-25, 2015*);
- Synchronized Sunday Mission Nationwide – a free anti-dengue simultaneous spraying in selected slum areas in Manila and various areas nationwide (*September 27, 2015*). Series of Barangay Dengue Orientation Seminars shall also be conducted in coordination with various Associations of Barangay Captains (ABC) in Metro Manila and other key cities in the provinces to be hosted by local government units, barangays or academes.

All concerned government agencies are enjoined to actively participate in the aforementioned activities.
